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MUSIC AT THE MALL – STUDENT GUIDELINES:

- Performance attire should be neat and in no way detract from the performance.
- **Ladies:** Dresses, skirts or dress pants: entire hemline must be knee length or longer when seated. No side slits. Blouses, tops, or sweaters must be "non-revealing". No spaghetti straps or halter tops allowed.
- **Gentlemen:** Dress or "polo" type shirt required. Slacks are required.
- **Both:** No shorts. No denim. Hair should be neat and out of the face. Shoes: No athletic shoes or flip-flops.
- **Pianists:** Shoes should allow for proper pedaling.
- Pictures and videos of events may be used by PMTA on their web site and/or in presentations. No individual names or personal information will be given.
