STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Performances must be polished and adhere to high performance standards. Auditions may be held at the discretion of your teacher.
- Students are allowed a maximum of two (2) pieces; for pianists and vocalists, repertoire selections must be memorized.
- Performance attire should be neat and in no way detract from the performance.
- Vocalists must abide by the Guidelines for Vocal Events.

I have read and agree to abide by these Guidelines.

- Ladies: Dresses, skirts or dress slacks: entire hemline must be knee length or longer when seated. No side slits.
- Blouses, tops, or sweaters must be modest and non-revealing. No spaghetti straps or halter tops are allowed.
- **Gentlemen**: Dress shirts and slacks are required. Ties, vests, coats/jackets preferred.
- **Both:** No shorts or denim clothing. Hair should be neat and out of the face. Shoes: no athletic shoes or flip-flops. Pianists' shoes should allow for proper pedaling.
- Pictures and videos of events may be used by PMTA on their web site and /or in presentations. No individual names or personal information will be given.
