STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES AND GUIDELINES:

- Fill out and sign this registration form. Must enter correct information regarding student's school grade.
- Make a copy, keep one copy for yourself and return the other to your teacher.
- Completely master your performance, both technically and musically. All music must be memorized (with the exception of those registering in Category B).
- All entrants must abide by the Federal Copyright Laws. Photocopies are not allowed. Entrants using .pdfs downloaded from the Internet will be asked to complete the Music Release Form verifying that they have permission to use this music. A Music Release Form must be signed for any photocopies being used. Student will be disqualified if these conditions are not observed.
- Bring music to the adjudication. Music should be clipped or marked and each measure numbered.
- Teacher or student name must not be found on music.
- Gold Medal winners must perform in the Gold Medal Winners' Recital. Failure to do so will result in ineligibility to participate in the next year's Fall Festival.
- Scheduled audition times CANNOT be changed. Order of registered pieces CANNOT be changed on audition day.
- Pictures and video of event may be used by PMTA on their web site/or in presentations. No individual names or personal information will be given.
- The following DRESS CODE must be followed at both the audition and the recital; failure to do so will result in immediate disqualification.
 - Ladies: Dresses or skirts of adequate length (at least to the knee when seated). Dress pants are allowed, no jeans or tight pants. Apparel is to be modest and non-revealing; no side slits or spaghetti straps.
 - Gentlemen: Dress or "polo" type shirt is required. Slacks are required. Ties, vest, suit coat or jacket are recommended, but not required.
 - All: Dress shoes are required for the auditions and the recital: no sneakers, gym, tennis, or boat shoes; no platform shoes (soles which are greater than one inch) or flip-flops. Hair must be neat and out of your face.
