PMTA SUMMER MUSIC CAMP SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE: To provide students with funds for summer music camp. The scholarship amount will be determined by the scholarship committee based on the applicant's age, musical experience, and the availability of funds.

ELIGIBILITY:

- The teacher must be a PMTA member.
- The teacher must be the instructor of the primary instrument that the applicant will study at camp.
- Students must be currently taking lessons from a PMTA teacher.
- Students must have participated in at least one PMTA-sponsored event the prior year.
- Students may be asked to perform for PMTA in the next calendar year.
- Priority will be given to first-time applicants.

DEADLINE: May 1st

The teacher and student will be contacted as soon as possible with the scholarship committee's decision. Award checks and letters will be mailed directly to the student and copied to the teacher.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

- A description of your musical involvements. Include private music study and all school, church, or community activities.
- A short essay on "What I hope to learn at summer music camp and how it might improve my music education."
- A copy of your completed summer camp application and camp information sheet. (Not the original.)

TEACHER RESPONSIBILITIES:

- A list of your personal involvement in PMTA include up to 3 years
- A letter of recommendation stating why your student should be considered for this scholarship
